- County Parks would like to do a collaborative effort with neighbors to apply for this round. They haven't been successful over the past few years in stand-alone applications.

- Discussion of use of herbicides and public opposition.

Andy reported that a WUI grant was received 2 weeks ago for \$49,000 for fuel break work around the Highlands.

Denise discussed the 2013 Clearing House grant. Payment has been difficult. Lack of staff.

Denise discussed the PG&E CEMA grant. \$15K was awarded. Working on a Euc removal project in Portola Valley.

Ramona has a PG&E project to do at Mt. San Bruno.

Denise is working on invoicing to the County.
